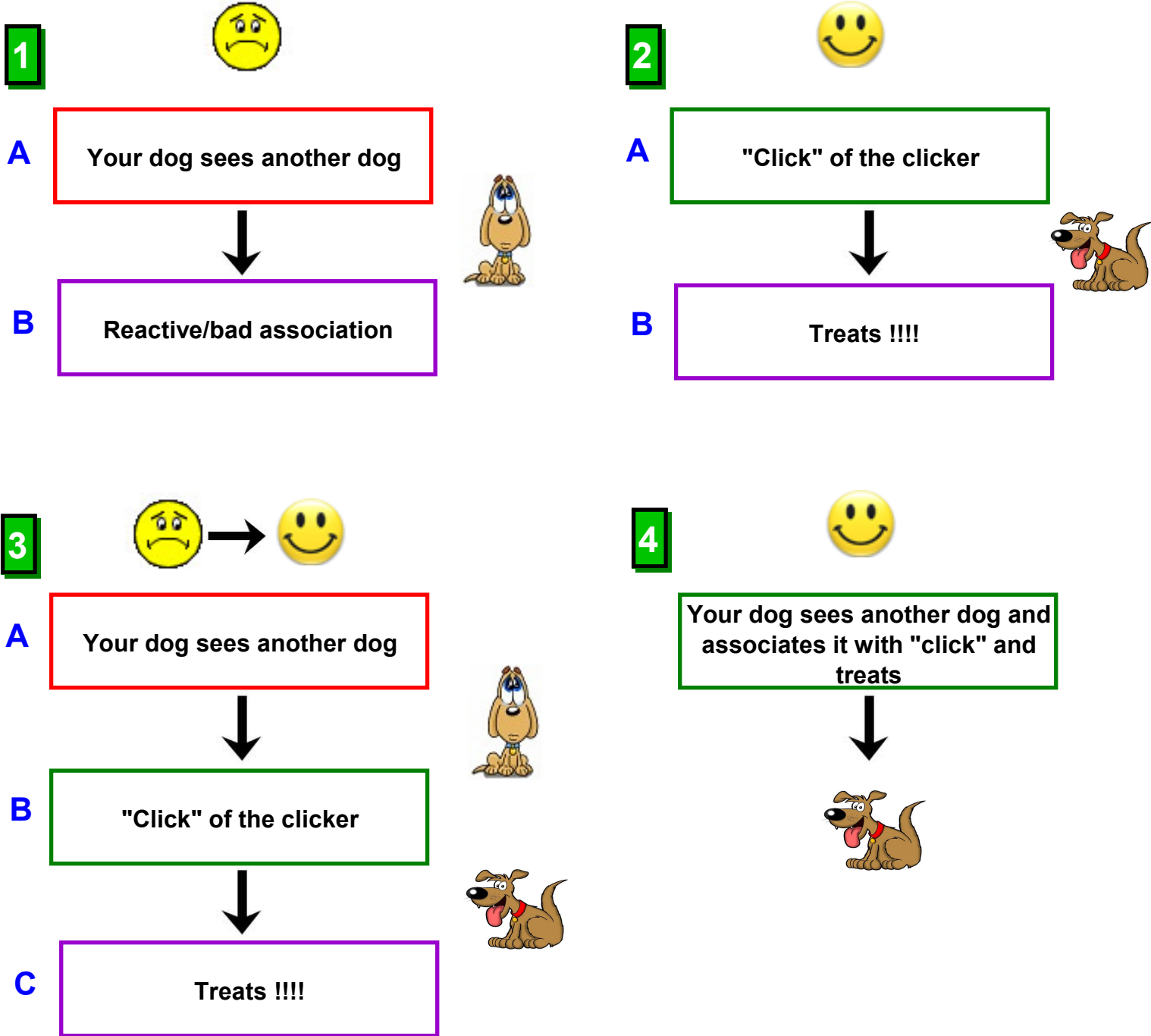

**Teach Your Dog to Go With the Flow**



The purpose of this exercise is to change your dog's reaction to other dogs by coupling item #'s 1 and 2 above. We'll start by giving your dogs LOTS of space and distance from other dogs. At the moment your dog becomes aware of another dog, click and reward. Repeat and repeat. If your dog reacts poorly to the sight of the other dog, provide more distance between the two. We will continue this process until your dog "flow charts" (item #3 above) that the sight of another dog predicts the "click" and reward. We'll discuss how you'll be able to recognize this. Once we have achieved #4 above, we can discuss establishing a cue (such as "sit") between 3A and 3B.
